# **IV.** Oral Reports

## a. Achievement

Jana Somma and members of the administrative team present an oral report of the Summer Search program, the elementary school's participation in the Carver Science Fair, and the Spring 2020 testing plan.

## b. Enrollment

Angela Villani states that whole school attendance is 92.69%, and current enrollment is 1,330. The school's enrollment cap this year is 1,328.

## c. Discipline

Andrew Boglioli states that there were 17 out of school suspensions in February, up from 15 last year. There were 30 in school suspensions, up from 28 last year.

## d. Budget to Actuals

Angela Villani presents the financial operations report as of January 2020. MBACS budgeted total enrollment at 1328 but the BoE approved an increase of 173 students. MBACS budgeted 283 special education students. The School District is paying MBACS regular education enrollment of 1043 and special education enrollment of 285. General Fund Revenue over expense current – \$2,013,162 under projected budget by \$292,168. Cash is \$5,473,358 - 96 days of cash on hand at 1/31/2020. 45 days required by bond covenant.
